Unlike fiberglass insulation, GREAT STUFF™ Pro Window & Door resists water intrusion and compresses easily as the frame expands and contracts, while still maintaining an adhesive bond.



Compressing fiberglass causes it to lose its insulating value. Stuffing fiberglass into the narrow, hard-to-fill gaps surrounding a window or door frame provides limited insulation value but a poor air seal.
